

# Supplications (Du'a) during Wudu

Begin by saying

## Bismillah Hirrohman Nirraheem

(In the name of Allah, the Most Beneficent, the Most Merciful)

<p><b>1.</b> To be said whilst washing hands</p>	<p><b>Allahumma inni asalukal yumna wa barkata wa aozubika minash shoomi wal halakati.</b> Oh Allah! I ask of Thee good fortune and blessing, and seek refuge in Thee from misfortune and destruction.</p>
<p><b>2.</b> To be said whilst washing mouth</p>	<p><b>Allahumma aa inni ala tilawati kitabeka wa kasratiz zikri laka wash shukri laka.</b> Oh Allah! Help me in the recitation of Thy book, and in remembering Thee most, and in offering Thee thanks.</p>
<p><b>3.</b> To be said whilst sniffing water into the nose</p>	<p><b>Allahumma arihni ra-ihatal jannati wa anta anni radhin.</b> Oh Allah! Comfort me with the smell of heaven and under the circumstances that Thou art pleased with me.</p>
<p><b>4.</b> To be said whilst blowing water out of the nose</p>	<p><b>Alahumma aozubika min rawaa-ihin nari wamin soo-iddari.</b> Oh Allah! I seek refuge in Thee from the smell of the fire and from the disgrace of the abode.</p>
<p><b>5.</b> To be said whilst washing face</p>	<p><b>Allahumma bayyidh waj hi yauma tabyadh-dhu wu juhu auliakaika wala tusawwid wajhi yauma taswaddu wu juho aadaaika.</b> Oh Allah! Brighten my face on the day when Thou wouldst brighten the faces of those who are dear to Thee, and do not blacken my face on the day when Thou wouldst blacken the faces of Thy foes.</p>
<p><b>6.</b> To be said when washing the right arm up to the elbow</p>	<p><b>Allahumma aatini kitabi bi yamini wa hasibini hasibanyaseera.</b> Oh Allah! Give me the record of my deeds in my right hand and subject me to an easy judgement.</p>

<p><b>7.</b> To be said whilst washing the left arm up to the elbow</p>	<p><b>Allahumma inni aozubika an tutiyani kitabi bi shimali aumin wara-i zahari.</b> Oh Allah! I seek refuge in Thee that I may be given the record of my deeds in my left hand or behind my back.</p>
<p><b>8.</b> To be said whilst wiping the head</p>	<p><b>Allahumma azillini tahta zilli arshika yauma la zilla illa zilla arshika.</b> Oh Allah! Give me the shade of shelter under Your throne on the day when there will be no shade other than the shade of Your throne.</p>
<p><b>9.</b> To be said whilst wiping the ears</p>	<p><b>Allahumma jalni minal lazenna yas tami-u-nal qaula fa yattabi-una ahsanahu alluhmma asmuni munadiyal jannati ma-al abrar.</b> Oh Allah! Make me as one of those who listen to an utterance and follow what is best in it. Oh Allah! Make me listen to the pronouncement of the heaven along with the virtuous people.</p>
<p><b>10.</b> To be said whilst washing the right foot</p>	<p><b>Allahumma sabbit qadamayya ‘ala siratikal mustaqeem</b> Oh Allah! Let my feet stick to the right path.</p>
<p><b>11.</b> To be said whilst washing the left foot.</p>	<p><b>Allahumma inni aoozobika an tazilla qadamayya alas sirati yauma aqdamul munafiqeena finnar</b> Oh Allah! I seek Thy refuge that my feet slip from the bridge on the day when the feet of the hypocrites slip into hell.</p>
<p><b>12.</b> End by saying</p>	<p><b>Ashadu an la illah ha ill’Allahu wahda hula sharikalah, Wa ashadu ana Muhammadan ‘ab duhu wa rasul</b> I testify that none has the right to be worshipped except Allah alone without partners, and I testify that Muhammad is His slave and messenger</p>
